

Installing QGIS

We will be setting up QGIS. Follow the instructions below, depending on your operating system.

Windows

- Open a web browser and go to <http://www.qgis.org>.
- Click **Download Now**.
- Download the latest version of **QGIS Standalone Installer** (currently 3.12). *Select the 64 bit version, unless you have a very old computer, or know that you need the 32 bit version.*
- Run through the program installation process.

OSX

- Open a web browser and go to <http://www.qgis.org>.
- Click **Download Now**.
- Under **Download for macOS** click **QGIS macOS Installer Version 3.12**.
- Follow through the installation wizard.

Linux/Ubuntu

- Open a web browser and go to <http://www.qgis.org>.
- Click **Download Now**.
- Expand the **Download for Linux** option.
- Follow the instructions for the appropriate Linux distribution.
